5. At least two (2) letters of endorsement, (i.e. Teachers, Principal or other prominent members of your community)
6. Must be a resident of Marlborough, NH
7. Direct decedents of Marshall H. Ford or Terry Ford Belair may apply
8. Length of Vocation School may vary at the digression of the selection committee
9. In addition to graduating students:
 - a) Recent military with honorable discharges pursuing a vocation may apply
 - b) First responders from the town of Marlborough may apply
10. A committee of three (3) from Croteau-Coutts-Ford American Legion Post 24 will be established to administer this scholarship
